

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in
the Church Hall in Creigiau on 21st October 2017**

1. I spoke to 5 residents in all.
2. Residents were from Creigiau and Pentyrch
3. Residents were updated on ongoing and resolved questions raised in August and September.

Concerns of Residents

4. A Creigiau resident commented on the progressively reducing visibility for traffic exiting Ffordd Dinefwr onto Tynant Road due to the overhanging trees and bushes. Can we ask Cardiff CC to pay attention to this as a specific when they do their planned tree maintenance in the area?
5. Several Creigiau residents mentioned the increase in traffic on Tynant Road which is becoming a “rat run” in their view. Comments were also made about the speed of this traffic.
6. Creigiau residents were pleased to see the recent Police presence around the school during drop of and pick up times. One resident has some photo’s which will be shared with the Police at the upcoming PACT meeting.
7. The continuing deterioration of the road surface on Tynant Road was raised. Residents were generally unsympathetic to what they view as excuses about why this is not being addressed by Cardiff CC.
8. One resident asked about PCC’s tree maintenance programme. It might be useful to put the schedule of tree inspection and maintenance on the PCC web site.
9. A Pentyrch resident raised a concern about the closure of Church Road and specifically about the inconsiderate parking of the contractors undertaking the work who are parking their vehicles in such a way as to obstruct access to driveways The resident reported a 30 minute delay before contractors moved a vehicle that was blocking a driveway.

Note – there will be no coffee morning surgery in November as the Church Hall Group are holding their Autumn Fair.
