

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in
the Creigiau Golf Club on 8th November 2017 at 19.00**

1. The meeting was held in combination with the Creigiau PACT meeting.
2. It was noted that some resurfacing work had been undertaken in response to our request to Cardiff Council. Cllr Graham Thomas was asked to pass on our thanks to Highways Dept.
3. It was noted that work to install the pavement on Robin Hill has now started following representations from PCC and our local Cardiff Councillors. The reasons for the delay were explained to residents.

Concerns of Residents

4. There were no specific issues raised outside of those raised in the PACT meeting. In this respect the major concern of residents remains the increased volume of through traffic using the village, the speed of the traffic and inconsiderate parking in the area around the junction of Tynant Road, Heol Creigiau and Tregarth Court. Cllr Graham Thomas will investigate what further mitigations might be possible with Highways Dept.

Note – there will be no coffee morning surgery in November as the Church Hall Group are holding their Autumn Fair.
