

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in  
the Creigiau Church Hall on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2017**

1. Several residents expressed their thanks for the efforts of councillors in getting the work on Robin Hill concluded before Christmas.

**Concerns of Residents**

2. Five residents expressed concern at the work being carried out on the A4119:
  - a. The contractors are not keeping the A4119 clean and mud and stones are being dragged onto the carriageway.
  - b. There has been some inconsiderate parking of contractors vehicles causing obstruction of the footway and the junction of the A4119 and Cardiff Road.
  - c. The removal of so much hedgerow was a major cause of concern.
  - d. The fact that the work is ongoing while the land is so wet was also a major concern as this will have an impact on the ecology of the area.
  - e. Residents questioned if the contractors were adhering to the planning conditions by carrying out the work so late in the year and removing so much hedgerow.
3. A resident asked about the Metro and when it would be started. I was able to update on the current provisional timetable.
4. A resident asked about the consultation from WAG about concessionary bus passes. I was able to explain this was at a consultative stage and no firm proposals have yet come forward.

The next Surgery will be held in the New Year.
