

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in  
the Creigiau Church Hall on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2018**

1. I attended the meeting and updated residents who have raised concerns previously.
2. I provided an explanation to all residents about why Tynant road had to be repaired in the way it has been.

**Concerns of Residents**

3. Many residents expressed concern about Tynant road. Now that the repairs have finished residents are finding it difficult to drive down the road and pass oncoming traffic due to the introduction of the kerbs. Cars speeding on the road is now a real concern as is the ever increasing volume of traffic now that the road is becoming an established “rat run” for through traffic. Some residents also mentioned aggressive driving behaviour by larger vehicles. A consensus from 25 residents present was that they would like PCC to make representations to:
  - a. Ask for a speed limit of 20mph on Tynant road.
  - b. Ask for a vehicle weight restriction to prevent heavy vehicles using the narrow section of the road between the A4119 and Ffordd Dinefwr.
  - c. Ask that prominent “narrow lane” warning signs are put at either end of the narrow section.
  - d. Ask that consideration is given to making the narrow section one way.
  - e. Write to bus and coach companies asking them not to use the lane.  
There was a particular complaint about Creigiau Travel raised in this regard.
4. Some residents asked if we could provide further clarification about the long term intent for the 63, 122, 124 and 136 buses. There is a rumour circulating that changes will be introduced at the end of the summer without further consultation.

The next Surgery will be held on 18<sup>th</sup> July 2018 at 10.00 hours in conjunction with the Coffee Morning at Creigiau Church Hall.
