

Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in the Creigiau Church Hall on 16th March 2019

1. I attended the meeting and updated residents who have raised concerns previously on any progress. Three of our community police officers also attended the coffee morning.

Concerns of Residents

2. Some residents enquired when the 20 zone was likely to be applied in Creigiau. The mechanism by which this happens was explained.
3. Some concern about the lateness of the re-surfacing programme in Creigiau was expressed?
4. Provided advice on how to use the app for notifying problems to CCC
5. Provided advice on how to apply for a council tax banding reduction.
6. The police answered a number of questions from residents and provided advice.
7. One resident made a complaint of obstruction of the footways near the doctors surgery in Creigiau by people parking half on the pavements.
8. One resident advised me of a theft from a shed as I was on the way to the meeting. Police were notified of same.
9. We were able to get 2 more Creigiau residents to sign up for the speed monitoring training. This means we now have 6 and the police can progress the training. Ideally the police would like a few more and would like a PCC council officer or PCC councillor to act as lead and co-ordinate speed watch efforts in the PCC area.

The next Surgery will be held on 20th April 2019 at 10.00 hours in conjunction with the Coffee Morning at Creigiau Church Hall.
