

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in
the Creigiau Church Hall on 18th May 2019**

1. I attended the meeting with Cllr Thorpe and updated residents who have raised concerns previously on any progress. Our community police officer also attended the coffee morning and provided information and guidance on securing property to prevent theft.

Concerns of Residents

2. A number of residents who are keen cyclists drew attention to the state of the Ty Nant Road near Smokey cot. The proximity of the bend and the fact the road surface is broken and potholed presents a considerable risk to cyclists using the lane. More so now the lane is being used as a cut-through by commuters and an increasing amount of the construction traffic. Residents would like the road in this area properly re-surfaced, they do not feel anything less will reduce the risk. The imposition of a weight limit was felt to be helpful if it can be obtained.
3. It was reported to me just after the meeting that a car has been seen parking inside the Skate Park and Creigiau Rec. Having had a look today it is possible to squeeze a small car past the bollards.

The next Surgery will be held on 15th June at 10.00 hours in conjunction with the Coffee Morning at Creigiau Church Hall.
