

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in
the Creigiau Church Hall on 15 June 2019**

1. I attended the meeting with Cllr Thorpe and Cllr Quilter, we updated residents who have raised concerns previously on any progress. Our community police officer also attended the coffee morning.

Concerns of Residents

2. A resident reported aggressive driving behaviour from an Edwards coach driver on Heol Creigiau, just past the golf club on the way out of the village. The driver forced several cars to reverse despite the fact that it would have been far easier for the coach to reverse the few yards back to where the road widens.
3. Overhanging trees on both sides of the road on station road were reported as causing a traffic hazard as they are forcing lorries and coaches into the middle of the road. It was explained to the resident how to report the matter to highways.
4. PCC policy on tree planting and monitoring for Ash die-back was explained.
