

**Report from Creigiau Ward Surgery Held in

1. I attended the meeting with Cllr Thorpe and updated residents who have raised concerns previously on any progress. Our community police officer also attended the coffee morning

**Concerns of Residents**

2. A number of residents asked about the introduction of a 20 mph limit in Creigiau. It was explained that PCC had been making representations to CCC for the last 2 years on this matter and the matter of improving and updating the traffic calming through the village. It was also pointed out that that nothing prevented residents driving at 20mph through the village now.
3. A resident raised a question about a circular letter for a Creigiau community web site that is circulating in the village purporting to come from a local resident. I was unable to confirm or deny the legitimacy of the invite to join a web based forum but urged caution. I also pointed out that there was already a well subscribed public Facebook Page which seemed to fulfil the same function and of course there was a lot of information on the PCC Facebook page and PCC web site.
