7. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 263, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW by 5 pm on Tuesday 26 April 2022.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Room 263, County Hall, Atlantic Wharf, Cardiff, CF10 4UW by 5 pm on Thursday 5 May 2022.
