Stagecoach have notified Cardiff Council that they are planning to reduce the frequency of the commercially provided 122 bus service that operates from Llantrisant to Cardiff City Centre along Llantrisant Road. They plan to reduce it from a 30minute frequency to an hourly frequency from Monday 12th August 2024.

Stagecoach have stated that they are having to take this action as the current frequency is financially unsustainable.

Stagecoach have confirmed that the 124 bus service will remain hourly and so there will still be a 30 minute service along Llantrisant Road. Cardiff Bus also operate their 62 bus service along Llantrisant Road to Rhydlafar on an hourly basis.

Granting the Freedom of Pentyrch is an honour that PCC can bestow. Although it carries no powers, rights or privileges, those who receive the honour are able to use the title of Freeman or Freewomen.

There is no statutory guidance that sets out any criteria for the appointment of Freeman and Freewomen. It is awarded in recognition of exceptional service to the community and Council may wish to consider awarding this status to:

- a. Persons of distinction, and
- b. Persons who have, in the opinion of the authority, rendered eminent service to the community

Individuals who have profited from their service would not normally be eligible, however this is subject to the discretion of the Council.

Due to the significance of a decision to award Freeman or Freewomen status not less than two thirds of members present are required to vote in favour of a resolution.
